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⇒ Немного грамматики

\*Verb "to be". Глагол «быть»\*

В настоящем простом времени глагол "to be" имеет три формы: 1)am 2)is 3)are. Все они переводятся одинаково – «есть». Для каждой формы есть свои местоимения. **Am – I Is – he/she/it Are – you/we/they**

Пример предложения с глаголом "to be".

+ (повествовательное предложение) *I am Andrey.*

- (отрицательное предложение) *I am not Andrey.*

? (вопросительное предложение) *Am I Andrey?*

⇒ Am/is/are + not

⇒ ↔ Глагол и местоимения меняются местами.

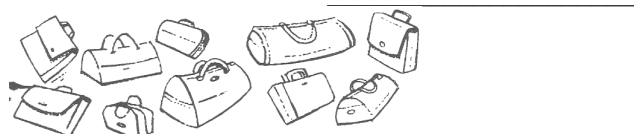
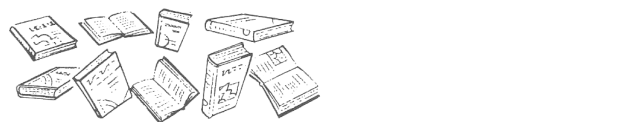
